

On the Farm

Sheep, Goats, Alpacas and Pigs – these can be seen around the main farm area in the animal paddocks which are all outside.

Ducks and Geese - these can be seen on the two ponds on the farm, the pond on the main farm yard has been refurbished during lockdown. And the 'B for Barleylands' pond in the outer farm area now has some residents.

Poultry Corner - see our chickens; including Jersey Giants. Plus pheasants and guinea fowl.

Wildlife Walk - discover bug hotels, beehives, hedgehog houses, pond life and more.

Goat Kids - during lockdown we've had over 25 goat kids born at the farm. See them and the nanny goats playing around enjoying the great outdoors.

Ponies and donkeys - say hello to Bobby and Freddie who are out enjoying the fresh grass in the paddocks. They have missed everyone during lockdown.

Highland Cattle and Billy Goats - see Annie and Flora the majestic Highland cows, and Rufus and Titan, who are fathers to all the new goat kids.

Walks and Trails - enjoy the fresh air and some space to let off some steam in the outer area of the farm park. And complete our interactive trails!!

Currently Not Open

In line with government legislation and social distancing guidelines the following areas are closed at the moment: Indoor play, outdoor adventure playgrounds, bouncy pillow, animal contact barn, Barleylands speedway, discovery centre, exotics and nocturnal house, and the aviary.

Health and Safety

- Please follow the one-way system and any other directional signage on site.
- Please observe the governments social distancing guidelines at all times. Areas of the farm have markings to help with this.
- Pregnant women are advised not to touch the animals.
- Please remember to wash your hands with soap and water regularly, doing so for at least 20seconds.
- Please make use of the hand sanitiser stations which are located all around the farm.
- Hand washing stations are situated at the entrance and by the toilet facilities. Please try to minimise children putting hands in or near their mouths; keep toys and dummies clean.
- The toilets will operate on a one in/ one out system. Please respect this to aid with social distancing. Facilities will be sanitised at regular intervals.
- Please do not flush wipes down the toilet; please dispose them in a bin.
- Picnic benches have been positioned with social distancing in mind, please don't move them. They are sanitised at regular intervals.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times and be supervised at all times.
- Fire assembly points are situated by the Wishing well, (map point 30), and in the main car park.
- The first aid point is at the reception, (map point 1), and accidents must be reported to a member of staff.
- No smoking on the farm (including e-cigarettes).
- Please follow staff instructions for a safe day out.
- Please watch out for and be aware of farm vehicles moving around the site.
