- The first aid point is at the Farm Park reception and accidents must be reported to a member of staff.
- Please watch out for and be aware of farm vehicles moving on site.

- No smoking on the farm (including e-cigarettes and vaping).
- Dogs are not allowed on the Farm Park.
- Please use the nappy changing facilities provided.
- Please use the bins provided.
- Do not pick up any of the animals.
- Do not climb on the fencing.
